During the month of March, it was a joy to see Redeemer continue to move forward in mission and ministry.

We completed the Be Like Jesus Challenge on Palm Sunday, and we were excited to pass out about 120 books this year. We hope that you all enjoyed the challenge, and that it makes a difference in your life past these 40 days of Lent!

During our special congregational voters meeting in March, Redeemer voted to send Stephanie and I to a continuing education program called 'Leadership Essentials' through PLI (Pastoral Leadership Institute), an organization that helps LCMS pastors grow in their leadership skills. The first session is in the middle of April, and we are excited about this opportunity to learn, grow, and better serve Redeemer. I'll include more information about our experience in future newsletters.

Back in December, Redeemer raised \$1000 to help support LCMS seminary students. Since we were able to send at least \$500 to each seminary, (Concordia Seminary in St Louis, and Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, IN), we will get assigned student from each seminary through their 'Adopt-A-Student' program. Our donation goes directly to help that student with the costs of thier education, and the students will send Redeemer updates on how their studies and personal life are going. We plan to include their letters in the newsletter, as we receive them, This past month, we also received our first letter from the student from Fort Wayne. His name is Noah Kerstein and he is originally from Pensacola FL.

And last but not least, I hope that you all join us for worship, ether in person or online, for Holy Week and Easter. We have a lot of different options available to accommodate your schedules, as well as allow for social distancing. Blessings on your Holy Week!




Stewardship Corner

Do you know there is a way that you can increase your contribution to Redeemer, AND save yourself some tax dollars at the same time?

With the increase in the standard deduction, most people no longer itemize their deductions on their income taxes, and instead take the standard deduction.

Once your income reaches a certain level, part of your social security benefits start to be taxed. And any distributions that you take from a tax deferred retirement plan (such as an IRA, TSA, Keogh, etc) not only add to your gross income, but also may increase the amount of tax that you could owe on your social security income.



However, if you make a direct donation to a charity from one of those plans, the donation is not included in your gross income and it is therefore not subject to taxes.

An example: Assuming you withdraw \$300 per month from your plan and have a 10% tax rate, you would have a net income of \$270 per month. Plus \$150 per month of your social security could be taxed at a 10% rate, costing an additional \$15 per month. If you made a direct donation to Redeemer from your tax shelter, Redeemer would receive \$300, and you would reduce your gross income by \$300, saving you \$30 in taxes on the distribution, and \$15 in taxes on your social security income. This assumes a 10% tax rate, and the savings could be higher if you are in a higher tax bracket.

Your financial institution has the forms that you would need to complete. It needs to be a direct contribution to Redeemer. You will get an 1099R showing the total distribution for the tax year. When you file there is a line to indicate the recipient, and it will not be added to your gross income.
