We had three services to allow for some social distancing in the pews, and nearly 100 people worshipped with us in person, in addition to many folks who tuned in online. And about a third of the people who came were not members or regular attendees. Many thanks to everyone who invited friends and family to attend with you! It was a great opportunity for us to share the message of Jesus this Christmas.

There is also a lot for us to look forward to in the new year. We are starting January with a worship series called 'Joy-FULL in 2021.' As we hope to start 2021 on a positive note, this series is a reminder that no matter if we classify 2021 as a good year or a bad year by worldly standards, we can still always live joyfully, because true joy comes from Jesus alone!

Lent starts early in 2021, with Ash Wednesday being on February 17th. Our theme for Lent is going to be 'The Being Challenge'. We will be doing another 40 day challenge, similar to the Red Letter Challenge from 2019. The Being Challenge, (which was also written by Red Letter Challenge author Zach Zendher) challenges us to spend 5 minutes a day in God's Word for 40 days. The goal of this challenge will be to explore 5 key habits that Jesus lived by, so that we can 'BE more like Jesus' in our daily lives. More information will be coming later in the month, but I want to encourage you all to consider accepting this challenge for Lent in 2021.

Thank you all for a wonderful year at Redeemer, and I am excited to see how the Lord uses us to connect more people to Jesus in 2021.
