# **Facility Updates**



We have completed quite a few updates to our campus during the month of June. At the beginning of the month, we installed a new AC unit for classroom 3-4, after the old unit died. The new unit has been working great, and we were able to get it in just in time for those two classrooms to be used for the four weeks of Summer Sunday School. The AC unit was not a budgeted item for the year, but we are thankful to have money available in our Building Replacement Fund to cover the cost.

The other big project that we completed was replacing the burned out spotlights in the back of the church with new LED lights. The new lights are on a timer, and they will come on every night to light up the stained glass windows in the back of the church building. If you are in the area at night, drive by and take a look! Even though they will run all night, the new LED lights are expected to last around 10 years, and will have a much lower energy cost than the old ones.

Earlier in the year, we replaced the burned out floodlights in our parking lot area, and replaced the globe lights in the front of the circle drive with new LED's as well.

Not only do the new lights help to illuminate our property so that it is more secure and safe in the evening, they also will help people who drive past at night to know that our church is here!
